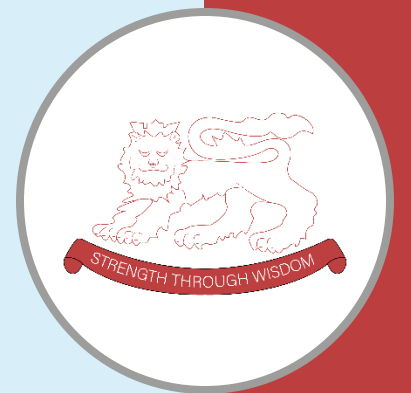

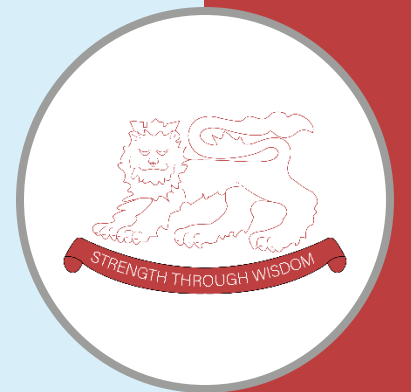

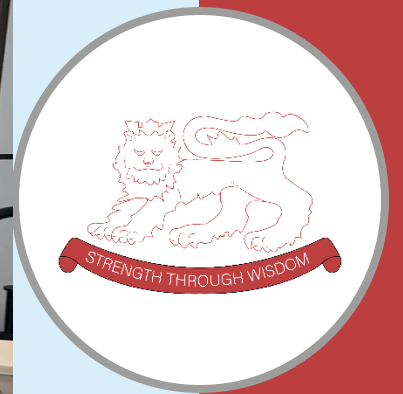


Accommodation

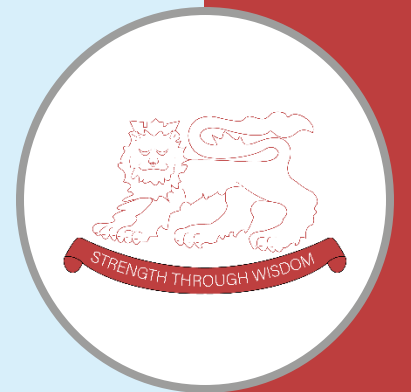

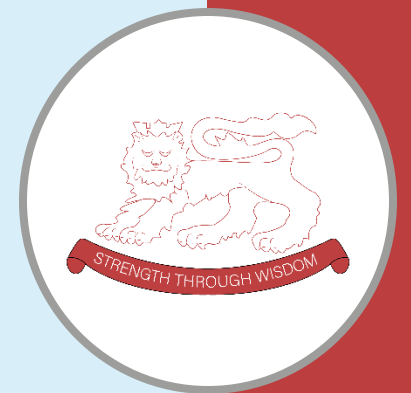

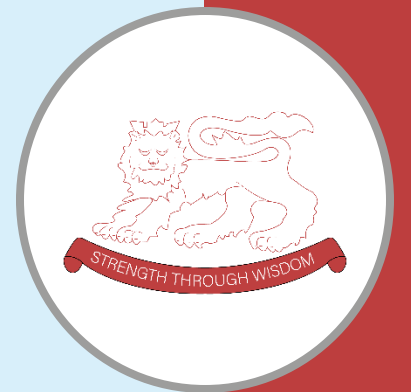


Key Details

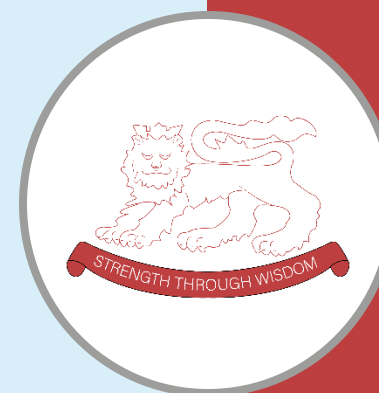
Parents, please ensure your child can carry their own kit at least 50 m and that a ticked-off, kit list is placed inside their case. This will ensure that at the end of their stay they may return home together with all the items with which they left. It will obviously help enormously if as much of their clothing as possible is clearly labelled.

Some of the activities at Danbury Outdoors require the use of long sleeves/ long trousers. Please bear this in mind when packing.

Bedding: Bottom sheet for single mattress, sleeping bag and pillow (or own duvet and duvet cover)

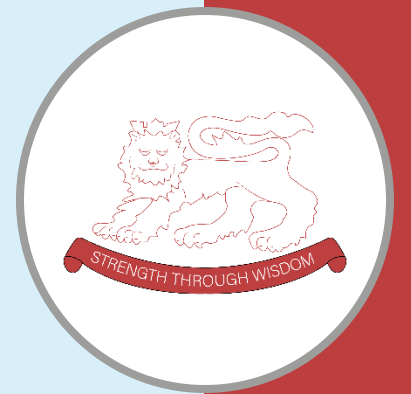
No money is permitted as there are no shops so there is nothing to buy!

Please label everything!



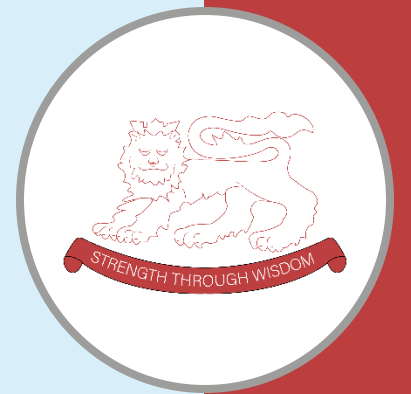
Medication
