Mobile Phones

Can we remind you of our expectations regarding mobile phones which some Y5/6 children are choosing not to follow despite being aware of them. In particular, please note the areas in bold which are currently our main areas of challenge. Thank you for your support with this.

- Where mobile phones are not deemed essential to bring to school, please leave them at home.
- Children will act responsibly at all times with their phones when travelling to and from school.
- Where children bring their mobile phones into school, they must be switched off on the school grounds.
- Mobile phones must be given to the Class Teacher at the start of the day. They will be returned at the end of the school day to the child.
- Mobile phones are not permitted on any school trips, sports events or residential trips.
- The school accepts no responsibility for the security of children's mobile phones at any time.
- The school reserves the right to confiscate a mobile phone where a child does not follow the guidance above. This may result in a meeting with the child and parents which could potentially result in them not being permitted to bring a phone onto school grounds.
